



Vital Equipment Refuel Service

Introduction

Vital Equipment are pleased to announce that they will provide a full refuel service on all 8 rounds of the 2010 Silverstone Tyres BTRDA Rally Series, where both Carless quality Race Fuels, and a competitively price Super Unleaded, will be available.

Competitors are encouraged to have their fuel dispensed directly into their rally cars from Vital Equipments Trading Standards approved electronic pumps in the safe environment of the refuel zone.

Taking advantage of the Vital Equipment Refuel Service, competitors will not have to carry their fuel in their Service Vehicles, which in turn, avoids the risk of breaking the laws on the carriage of Hazardous Goods. It also avoids potential insurance problems in the event of any unforeseen accident.

Fuel Ordering – *made simple*

The information that will require is as follows:-

- The type of fuel required.
- The maximum quantity of fuel you expect to use on the rally

- A contact Mobile No' for one of your team during the rally
- E-mail address
- Invoice address
- Credit/Debit card details to cover payment

Competitors will only be charged for the fuel they use. Therefore, if you order 100lts and only use 75lts, you will only be charged for 75ltrs.

On-event Operation

Prior each rally the Vital Equipment Refuel Operation will setup a minimum of one hour prior to the opening time for scrutineering, and details of the refuelling location will be the Final Instruction.

During the rally the Refuel Area will be in the organisers Refuel Zone in the Service Park, and will operational a minimum of 30 minutes prior to the due time of arrival of the first car.

Fuel Records

While Vital Equipment Refuel Staff will record the amount of fuel dispensed into each rally car, it is recommended that co-drivers also make a record in their road books.

Post Event

Competitors will receive, by e-mail, and invoice showing the No' of litres used and charged.
